Instructions to Administer YES CLUB PRE-SURVEY

Instructions:

- 1. When you begin working with a new group, please give them the pre surveys to complete at the first YES Club meeting. (Ask your site supervisor to make copies so that every student can complete one.)
- 2. Read through the survey so you are familiar with the questions.
- 3. Distribute the survey to the students and ask them to answer the questions. You may want to read each question aloud, especially with younger students, discuss with them what each question is asking. For instance, you may want to help them understand what "community" means. Also, remind students that there is no right or wrong answer.
- 4. Once you have collected pre surveys for all the members in your YES Club, ask your site supervisor to mail them to the address below:
