The event featured a cooking demonstration, youth activities, and a \$17,000 Community Credits donation from DoorDash

TRENTON, NJ – Today, New Jersey Assembly Speaker Craig Coughlin joined representatives from the Boys & Girls Clubs of Mercer County, New Jersey Office of the Food Security Advocate (OFSA), and DoorDash to mark Hunger Action Month with a community event at the Club's Trenton Clubhouse.

The celebration featured activities focused on healthy eating and nutrition, including an interactive cooking demonstration led by the Club's culinary staff.
